

PURCHASING SPECIALIST -- responsible for negotiating pricing and contracts with approved Felker vendors, originate quote requests for service center material and purchase various products required by the Fabrication and Piping Products divisions. Position requires strong written and oral communication skills, working knowledge of both Microsoft Word[®] and Microsoft Excel[®], and ability to work both independently and as part of a team. Educational equivalent of a bachelor's degree or at least four years' experience in purchasing, sales or related field is preferred.

ESTIMATOR -- this position requires preparation of accurate labor and material estimates utilizing AutoCad; communication with customers to assist with the understanding of project requirements and offer economic alternatives to their designs; preparation of proposal cover page, scope of supply, general notes, exclusions/clarifications, and information sheets for each bid; follow-up on proposals to determine award status and competitiveness and communication with internal personnel on status of bids. Position requires strong communication skills, ability to read and create (AutoCad) drawings, good organizational and business skills and the ability to handle multiple tasks. An associate degree with an emphasis in engineering/design is preferred.

SEMISKILLED: This is an entry level production position. Assigned work areas may include pickling, warehouse, shipping and receiving, grinding and operating rolls and presses. High school diploma, or equivalent, required.
